What is NEW about our program

Our Catechism program follows a **Rotational Blended Learning Model** consisting of alternating weeks of **in-person** sessions (@ Our Lady of Pompei Church), **on-line** sessions (Zoom) and **independent** activities (self-paced at home learning). A schedule is provided at the start of each Catechism Year. Classes commence the first Sunday of October and run until the last Sunday of April. Sacrament celebrations take place in the month of May.

Sunday Mass

Sunday Mass attendance is a requirement of our program. Catechism Families are expected to participate at our 11:15am Sunday Mass Celebration (in-person) at Our Lady of Pompei Church. Attendance is taken. Sunday and other Holy Days of Obligation are days on which the faithful are expected to attend Mass, and engage in rest from work and recreation, according to the Third Commandment. Therefore Mass, Prayer and Family Time should be your Sunday focus. You have a big responsibility to be a good role model for your child. Children often grow up to mimic the behaviors, attitudes and beliefs of their parents and caregivers. Be the role model your child deserves.

Attendance Policy

All children are expected to attend class and mass as per the schedule unless a serious reason prevents the child from attending. Poor attendance and/or excessive tardiness may require the child to repeat the year.

- ❖ Always demonstrate proper behaviour
